

Abstract Submission Guidelines

General Instructions

- Abstracts must be submitted electronically via the official symposium website.
- Each presenting author may submit multiple abstracts, but each abstract must be submitted separately.
- All abstracts must be written and presented in English.
- Submission deadline: **1st August 2026**. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Choose the appropriate subject category and keywords to describe the scientific content of your abstract. For example, a study on the effects of the nurse navigator program on breast cancer patients would be submitted with the subject category “nursing” and keywords “breast cancer” and “patient navigation”.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by our Scientific Committee.
- Notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent by 5th September 2026.
- Authors should specify whether they want to submit their abstract for a free paper (oral presentation) and/or e-poster presentation (electronic poster display).
- All e-poster and free paper presenters must register for the symposium on the symposium website.
- If selected for a free paper, one presenting author must confirm their physical attendance by 15th September 2026. Virtual presentation of free papers is discouraged.

Abstract Title

- The title should be brief, specific, and clearly reflect the content.
- Use sentence case (capitalize only the first word and proper nouns).
- Do not use abbreviations or acronyms in the title.

Authors and Affiliations

- Provide full names of all authors.
- Indicate the presenting author clearly.
- Include institutional affiliations, city, and country for all authors.

Abstract Body

- Maximum length: 2,200 characters including spaces (excluding title and author details).
- Structure your abstract as follows:
 - Background / Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion
- Use standard abbreviations; spell out special or uncommon abbreviations at first mention.
- Do not include references, figures, or tables in the abstract body.

Ethical Considerations

- All research must comply with ethical standards.
- Human and animal studies should indicate appropriate ethical approval.

Declaration

- A mandatory checkbox will confirm whether this research has been previously published in a journal.
- The submitting author is responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information.
- Abstracts that have been previously published in a research journal will not be eligible for the Ahsan Rashid Memorial Medal.
