5. **Assess** novel surgical and interventional oncology techniques that reduce perioperative complications and improve long-term outcomes.
6. **Foster** multidisciplinary collaboration among clinicians, researchers, allied health professionals, and patient advocacy groups to strengthen cancer prevention, treatment, and survivorship care across Pakistan.
